ABOUT THE WINE

We love Sauvignon Blanc and after a few years of vineyard experimentation, we have found our vineyard sources that support the expression and character we believe in. The arrangement for this wine could not be simpler - two highly touted vineyard partners, 100% Sauvignon Blanc, 100% Sonoma Valley and with a few winemaking twists.

TASTING NOTES

This anytime sipper has always been a staple for the Highway 12 portfolio. The 2018 is youthful and bright with its clean, citrus-zested nose. Round and fruity, yet refined. Mid palate notes of green apple with a slightly lingering tropical fruit finish. Enjoy with minerally raw oysters, steely steam clams, Asian fare or simply on its own.

WINEMAKING & VINEYARDS

Our vineyard partners for this wine are local Sonoma boys Ned Hill and Matt Stornetta of La Prenda Vineyards and the MacLeod Family in Kenwood. Here we combine the best of the central and southern ranges of Sonoma Valley showcasing the intense fruit-forward qualities of Kenwood and the delicate, cooler climate minerality of Southern Sonoma. A true expression of Sonoma winegrowing.
