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Who is the Highwayman?

Highwayman Wines are small production, site specific wines that represent the top lots from selected vineyards in Sonoma Valley. The name represents the historical "Highwayman" that preyed on travelers traveling the roads in the 1800's and frequented rustic highways in California and throughout Europe.

Where the Highwayman Roam

From the beginning we have sourced fruit from iconic vineyards in Sonoma Valley's southern region, commonly known as the "Banana Belt". Due to the warm climate and warm soils caused by geothermal activity in the area, the results are powerfully elegant wines that are big in concentrated fruit with softer, round tannins.

The Blend

Each vintage our Trailblazer provides us with a platform to showcase our appreciation of the giant, somewhat unctuous marriage of Zinfandel, Cabernet Sauvignon and Petite Sirah. Barrel aging in French oak adds a hint of toastiness and slightly softens the wines tannin structure.

Tasting Notes:

Deep purple color. Bright and dense boysenberry and red currant jelly with hints of strawberry licorice are the result of the marriage of zinfandel cabernet sauvignon and petite sirah. Hints of black cherry, vanilla and spice linger on the long finish.
