Tasting Notes:

Lively acidity creates a multi-faceted palate that shows off the delicacy of this wine, sending it into a warm finish with subtle tannins. It's a vivid expression of the cooler growing season, where fresh fruit shines and hints of spice and black olive complement -- creating a tailored experience in each sip.
