Highwayman Wines are small production, site specific wines that represent the top lots from selected vineyards in Sonoma Valley. The name represents the historical "Highwayman" that preyed on travelers traveling the roads in the 1800's and frequented rustic highways in California and throughout Europe.

Where the Highwayman Roam

From the beginning we have sourced fruit from iconic vineyards in Sonoma Valley's southern region, commonly known as the "Banana Belt." Due to the warm climate and warm soils caused by geothermal activity in the area, the results are powerfully elegant wines that are big in concentrated fruit with softer, round tannins.

The Blend

A crowd favorite at the winery, our Highwayman Reserve Proprietary Red exhibits the rich, powerful elegance of the Bordeaux varietals grown in this unique section of Sonoma Valley.

Tasting Notes:

The 2019 vintage is LIGHTS OUT DELICIOUS! Complex and elegant yet powerful, we love this balance of ripe fruit, herbal aromatic intensity, minerality and structural power. Concentrated levels of creme de cassis, chocolate and graphite give way to a full-bodied and seamless wine that over-delivers yet again.
