WHO IS THE HIGHWAYMAN

Highwayman wines are small-production, site-specific bottlings crafted from select top lots in Sonoma Valley. The name draws inspiration from the legendary highwaymen of the 1800s: bold, elusive figures who traveled the rustic roads of California and Europe, leaving behind an enduring sense of mystery, adventure, and untamed character.

WHERE THEY ROAM

From the beginning, we have sourced fruit from iconic vineyards in Sonoma Valley's southern "Banana Belt," where warm days, heat-retentive soils, and geothermal influence yield wines of depth and elegance, marked by concentrated fruit, supple texture, and round, polished tannins.

THE BLEND

Zinfandel leads the charge at 85%, backed by our heritage crew of Petite Sirah, Carignane, and Alicante Bouschet all in equal portions. Plus, fresh new sources (even a field blend) that keep the flavors unrivaled and the Highwayman journey moving forward.

TASTING NOTE

Trailblazin' bursts with blackberry compote, raspberry jam, wild strawberry, cracked black pepper, dried sage, and violet. Ripe Zinfandel fruit leads, Carignane adds bright snap, Petite Sirah brings structure, and Alicante Bouschet lends a dark, inky edge. Plush yet fresh, it finishes long with brambly fruit, warm spice, cocoa nib, smoky anise, and dusty trail-side earth.
