WHO IS THE HIGHWAYMAN

Highwayman wines are small-production, site-specific bottlings crafted from select top lots in Sonoma Valley. The name draws inspiration from the legendary highwaymen of the 1800s: bold, elusive figures who traveled the rustic roads of California and Europe, leaving behind an enduring sense of mystery, adventure, and untamed character.

WHERE THEY ROAM

From the beginning, we have sourced fruit from iconic vineyards in Sonoma Valley's southern "Banana Belt," where warm days, heat-retentive soils, and geothermal influence shape wines of depth and elegance. These sites produce concentrated fruit, supple texture, and round, polished tannins, giving Highwayman its bold yet refined character.



TRAILBLAZIN'

Trailblazin' is a bold, high-energy red with serious crowd appeal. Ripe Zinfandel drives the wine with blackberry compote, raspberry jam, and wild strawberry, while Carignane adds freshness, Petite Sirah brings structure, and Alicante Bouschet gives it a dark, inky edge. Plush but lively, it finishes long with brambly fruit, warm spice, cocoa nib, smoky anise, and dusty trail-side earth.

Appellation: Sonoma County
Varietal(s): 85% Zinfandel, then Petite Sirah, Carignane, and Alicante Bouschet split evenly.
Alc: 14.2%
Aging: 14 mo. barrel aging in French oak

PROPRIETARY RED

This is a bold, polished red that delivers serious impact in the glass. It has the richness customers love—crème de cassis, dark chocolate, and graphite—balanced by herbal lift, minerality, and a smooth, full-bodied finish. Powerful, seamless, and consistently overdelivering, this is an easy wine to get behind year after year, both tableside and on the floor.

Varietal(s): 62% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Cabernet Franc, 8% Petite Sirah, 8% Syrah
Alc: 14.8%
Aging: 16 mo. barrel aging in French oak

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Known as "The Ultra Cab," this 100% Cabernet Sauvignon is built for power, polish, and serious dark-fruited impact. Deep violet-ruby in the glass, it delivers concentrated black currant, cassis, blackberry, and vanilla, layered with gravelly minerality and lead pencil. Tannins and a long, luscious finish give it the structure and swagger to overdeliver in true Highwayman fashion.

Appellation: Sonoma County
Varietal(s): 100% Cabernet Sauvignon (All hail the king!)
Alc: 14.8%
Aging: 14 mo. barrel aging in French oak
