



WHY CARNEROS

Carneros is where Sonoma's southern edge meets the cool influence of the bay, a landscape of rolling hillsides, lingering fog, and vineyard rows washed in coastal light. Here, the growing season unfolds slowly, allowing Chardonnay and Pinot Noir to build depth without losing their natural brightness. Cool mornings preserve freshness, gentle afternoons develop texture and flavor, and the region's windswept character leaves its signature in every glass. The result is wine with poise and tension, richness and restraint—singular expressions of Carneros shaped by fog, time, and the quiet majesty of the coastal hills.



HISTORIC SITES

Our Carneros Highway wines are drawn from a collection of prized Carneros vineyards rooted in generations of farming heritage. Cultivated by the Sangiacomo family, growers in Sonoma since 1904, these sites represent some of the appellation's most trusted ground for cool-climate Chardonnay and Pinot Noir. Fog-cooled mornings, windswept afternoons, and careful farming shape fruit with brightness, texture, and unmistakable Carneros character. From these historic vineyards come wines that feel both timeless and precise: elegant, expressive, and connected to place.

CHARDONNAY

Carneros Highway Chardonnay opens with golden apple, dried pineapple, Meyer lemon, and ripe pear, lifted by fog-cooled freshness. Barrel fermentation and malolactic richness bring graceful texture, with notes of vanilla, soft oak, and baking spice. Bright citrus acidity carries the finish, keeping the wine balanced, elegant, expressive, and polished. 100% barrel-fermented with 100% malolactic fermentation.

PINOT NOIR

Carneros Highway Pinot Noir captures the poise and delicacy of its cool-climate origins. Aromas of wild strawberry, red cherry, hibiscus, and rose petal unfold alongside hints of sandalwood, cedar, and subtle French oak. The palate is bright and silky, with refined red fruit, gentle spice, and a graceful finish that reflects the fog-hugged hillsides of Carneros, with lingering purity and coastal refinement.
